

On March 11, 2005, Kevin Berthia climbed over the rail on San Francisco's iconic Golden Gate Bridge. Overwhelmed by recent events in his life, he was seconds away from leaping to his death. Then he heard four words that changed his life. "Hey, wait a minute."



For 92 minutes, Sgt. Kevin Briggs of the California Highway Patrol listened to Mr. Berthia without judging. By listening to understand, he persuaded Mr.



Berthia to climb to safety and receive help.

Today, 12 years later, the two have teamed up. Their goal? To make a difference by offering hope to others.
