

Eligibility Criteria

Admission Criteria

Individuals must be 18 years of age or older and be willing to enter the facility on a voluntary basis. These adults must be facing a psychiatric crisis and need a short term supportive environment, and/or are a danger to themselves or having suicidal thoughts. Individuals entering the facility must be able to care for their own personal needs.

Discharge Criteria

Discharge planning begins the day the client enters the program. Staff will work closely with the client to achieve any unmet needs as well as link the client to appropriate community services and resources to help prevent future crises and improve the individual's quality of life. Clients will discharge when they have met their treatment goals and have become stabilized.

Transition Criteria

Readmission Criteria

Exclusionary or Ineligibility Criteria

Individuals who are a danger to others, who require a nursing facility level of care, who require Detox, and who are unable to care for their own personal needs are not appropriate for admission.
