Eligibility Criteria

Admission Criteria

Referrals may be made through Point of Entry or directly to the TRP. Referrals may come from a psychiatrist, therapists, RVBH providers, other community agencies, families or consumers themselves. An Axis I diagnosis must be present and must be the primary problem. Axis II diagnosis are also acceptable. The consumer must have a documented hospitalization. Disability with a serious impairment must be present in at least two of the following areas: vocational/educational, independent living, community negotiations, social relationships, self-care, or legal status. The individual must be 18 years of age.

Discharge Criteria

Discharge planning will begin at admission to the program. Consumers will be assisted in planning for the future emphasizing their strengths, gains achieved during program involvement, abilities and preferences.

Transition Criteria

Transition planning begins upon admission to the program and continues throughout the treatment process. Prior to the consumer transitioning out of the program, other services will be reviewed and assigned as needed.

Readmission Criteria

Same as admission criteria.

Exclusionary or Ineligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible for the program, a consumer must have a diagnosis that meets the requirements of a Severe Mental Illness (SMI), and must have Medicaid.
