## **CASE MANAGEMENT**

Case Management is a collaborative process that brings together services, supports, agencies, resources, and people to help children, adolescents, and adults achieve their goals. Waiver Case Management also available.

# OUTPATIENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Six outpatient clinic locations available in western Kentucky offering individual, family, and group therapy and substance abuse services to children, adolescents, and adults.

# THERAPEUTIC COMMUNITY SUPPORT (TCS)

A service designed to act as an extension of therapy in a community setting. This program provides information to assist clients in developing thinking and acting skills to more effectively meet their needs

# INTENSIVE IN-HOME FAMILY SERVICES

An extension of therapy services designed for participants who need additional behavioral interventions outside of a therapist's office. Consumer-focused, family-focused promoting specific treatment plan objectives.

# REGIONAL CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY PROGRAM

Intensive outpatient program for those seeking recovery from a chemical dependency of alcohol and or drugs. Separate living accommodations available for men and women while participating in the program.

#### KIDS Now Plus Program

A program focused on serving women who are pregnant and who are at-risk for alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use during pregnancy.

# CHILDREN'S PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITAL

Inpatient acute care psychiatric hospital available for children ages 5 to 17. Person-centered services that diagnose, treat, and stabilize behavioral and mental health issues in children resulting in an improvement of the child's overall capacity to function. Specialized services are offered in the areas of

- Autism Spectrum Disorder services, partnering with the Cleveland Clinic
- Substance Abuse
- Acute Psychiatric Inpatient Services
- Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy

Children also continue their education while attending our accredited on-site school.

# CHILDREN'S PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITIES (PRTF)

An alternative to hospitalization and less restrictive. Serving children ages 6-11 and boys ages 12-17 with serious emotional and behavioral problems. Homes are situated in a residential area providing a home-like environment.

## **CRISIS SUPPORT SERVICES**

Crisis response support services for children and adult individuals with an intellectual/developmental disability who are experiencing an immediate crisis.

# CRISIS STABILIZATION UNIT (CSU)

A program for adults facing a psychiatric crisis and/or are a danger to themselves or having suicidal thoughts and in need of a short term supportive environment. Individuals entering the facility must be able to care for their own personal needs. Entry is voluntary.

# ASSERTIVE COMMUNITY TREATMENT (ACT)

A mobile program providing psychosocial services directed to adults with severe and persistent mental illness who often have co-occurring problems such as substance abuse or are homeless or involved with the judicial system. The program provides assistance to individuals to maximize their recovery, provide assistance in helping the persons served become respected and valued member of their community.

# THERAPEUTIC REHABILITATION PROGRAM (TRP)

A Medicaid eligible day treatment program for adults with a severe mental illness who require more than out-patient counseling but less than 24 hour care. Individual and group therapy is offered along with skill building services.

RiverValley is a not-for-profit organization and is partially funded by reimbursements from Federal, CHFS, and the Commonwealth of Kentucky sources.
